Notice of Race

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Rules, and the sailing instructions.

2 Schedule

Sunday report time	0930
Competitors Meeting	0945
First start Sunday	1020
No Sunday start after	1500

Note: the boathouse will not open before 0900 for early arrivals on Sunday.

3 Sailing Instructions will be available via Tech Score by Friday

4 Format

“A” division will start with two races, followed by “B” division, alternating throughout.

5 Courses

5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)

5.2 Courses 5 & 6 are also possibilities.

6 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way. Standing rigging shall not be adjusted. If you believe your rig tension is not set correctly, please speak with a Tufts sailor. Spare clevis pins and cotter rings will NOT be supplied if you lose any. To disconnect the jib from the mast when de-rigging, simply turn the T-lock 90 degrees and it will release from the mast—DO NOT remove the pin connecting the head of the jib to the upper forestay.

7 Protests

7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.

7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Conference Room or the Porter Family Kitchen/office.

8 Prizes for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

The Observation deck is open. The top floor is also open but no gear bags may be left there. Change elsewhere.
