

Keelhauler Open Regatta

NOTICE OF RACE

This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

ENTRY

Only one team per school is allowed, and entries are limited to 13 teams. If all 13 spots do not fill, schools may send a second team with the host having priority. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. There is no entry fee or charter fee.

LOCATION

Boats will sail from the CMA boat basin. Racing will occur in Morrow Cove immediately adjacent to the CMA campus waterfront. Spectating is available over the entire campus waterfront.

The GPS address is 200 Maritime Academy Drive, Vallejo CA. Drive all the way down the hill and follow the waterfront for parking.

BOAT BASIN/DOCKS

The CMA docks and boat basin area are a secure port facility. Only competitors and coaches are allowed inside the gate. All personnel must be escorted by a CMA cadet or staff and may be asked to provide identification.

BOATS and SAILS

The regatta will be sailed in FJs. CMA can provide up to 13 boats as available. Teams need to provide their own class legal sails. Local teams and teams with ability are asked to bring their own boats to free boat availability for teams unable to bring their own.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be made available on TechScore the week prior to the regatta and on site upon arrival on Saturday.

COACHING

A coach boat will be available. Coaches will be provided with a radio and may need to assist on the water. A spectator boat may also be available.

FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta with one entry per school. Divisions will rotate every two races and remain in their initially assigned boat throughout.

LUNCH

There will a variety of food trucks on site for the regatta. The CMA dining hall is on campus adjacent to the waterfront and open for racers and spectators.

PARKING

Parking is available along the CMA campus waterfront providing close views of the racecourse. Teams are required to purchase daily parking passes from self-serve kiosks in the parking lot. Teams will be responsible for their own parking passes and will be subject to tickets.

No parking is allowed inside the secure boat basin area.
