1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Prescription of US Sailing will apply except as altered by the ICSA Procedural Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules and the Sailing Instructions.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the main white board located at the UH Boat House.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES:

- 3.1 Dates & Times of Racing & Meetings etc.
Saturday & Sunday April 22 & 23, 2023

Report Time: 9:00am

Sailors Meeting: 9:15am

First Start: 10:00am

No race will be started after 4:00pm Sunday April 23, 2023

3.2 Dinghy/Format:

We will attempt to sail a single round robin.

Ties will be broken according to ICSA procedural rules.

Boat rotation will be done at the Marine Center dock.

4 THE COURSES

- 4.1 Attachment 1 shows the courses.

Course 1 - Windward/Offset/Leeward gate/Windward/offset finish to leeward (2 laps)

Course 2 - Windward/Offset/leeward gate finish to windward (1.5 laps)

Course 3 - Triangle, windward, triangle mark, leeward mark (finish to windward)

4.2 Starting/finishing mark/pin will be a white mark

4.3 Windward/leeward gate will be orange colored.

5 RECALLS

An attempt will be made to hail competitors by sail and bow #, however, it is the responsibility of the sailor to start properly.

6 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 6.1 Follow the procedures set up in the ICSA rulebook.

6.2 Protest forms can be obtained from the registration table.

6.3 Protests must be filled with in 15 minutes following the set of races which the incident occurred.

6.4 Protests may be heard as soon as possible during each day.

6.5 The right of appeal is denied at all Conference Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.
