1. SI 7.2 is amended to read:

Techscore rotation doesn't show the sail numbers for 420's sail # 11-20 correct. For the purpose of the online rotation, the division assigned to the 420 fleet with sail # 11-20 will actually use sail numbers as listed below:

Sail #1 on the online rotation will equal sail #11

Sail #2 on the online rotation will equal sail #12

Sail #3 on the online rotation will equal sail #13

Sail #4 on the online rotation will equal sail #14

Sail #5 on the online rotation will equal sail #15

Sail #6 on the online rotation will equal sail #16

Sail #7 on the online rotation will equal sail #17

Sail #8 on the online rotation will equal sail #18

Sail #9 on the online rotation will equal sail #19

Sail #10 on the online rotation will equal sail #20

2. SI 7.3 is amended to read:

Divisions will sail all 9 races in one fleet of boats. Sailors will rotate to a new sail number after 3 races but will remain in their originally assigned fleet. Fleet assignments are as follows: B division will sail in 420's 1-10

C division will sail 420's 11-20 with sail numbers modified in amendment #1 to match the online rotation.

A division will sail in FJ's 1-10

3. Each fleet will get a short break of about 25 minutes to have a little food and use the restrooms. We will pull the boats out of the water and take both sails down during the break. Please remove your rudder and secure the boat in the cradle Please secure your sails so they do not blow out of the boat.
