Visiting Team Information

Parking – each team will receive one parking pass upon arrival for parking for one vehicle per team in the Edgewood Yacht Club south parking lot (to the right) or on the hill to the club. Any additional vehicles including spectators will be asked to park on the main road, Narragansett Boulevard. We need to keep enough parking available for volunteers, umpires, the broadcast team, and Edgewood Yacht Club members. Please pass this information along to your parents and anyone else associated with your programs.

Daily Arrival – please do not arrive before 8:45am each day. You will not have access to anything until after this time.

Restrooms - there are restrooms available in the green building in the North parking lot (to the left), on the second floor of the Edgewood Yacht Club, and in the Ted Turner '60 Sailing Pavilion on the 3rd floor.

Team Set-up – we ask that teams **do not set up tents** as there is not space available. Each team will have a picnic table and seating on the first floor/deck level of the Edgewood Yacht Club. Please leave the main walkway open for people to walk through.

“Field of Play”- the ICSA requests that the host provide the competitors and coaches with an area that is considered the “Field of Play”. This area is an area that only competitors, coaches and regatta officials can access. For this event, the spectators shall not enter the rotation docks or docks of the Edgewood Yacht Club. This is considered a “field of play” and is only open to registered competitors, coaches, official team support personnel, regatta officials, and official media personnel. The main pier/walkway will not be considered the “Field of Play”. Spectator boats shall not dock at the rotation dock or enter the docks of the Edgewood Yacht Club.
