
Attachment A - Course Chart

Notes:

-'W/O' denotes a weather mark followed by an offset mark, both rounded to port. -'Gs' and 'Gp' denotes a gate, where 'Gs' is rounded to starboard and 'Gp' is rounded to port.

-The 'Fin U' line may use the offset mark as the finish pin if no separate finish pin is set. In this case, the finish boat would locate with the windward mark on its starboard side.

-The windward mark, offset mark, and the gate marks may be yellow tetrahedrons or orange balls.

-The starting and finishing pins will likely be Orange balls or orange tetrahedrons.
