NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028. 1.2 The Intercollegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition and the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This is a foundational level regatta. Contact the Regatta Coordinator for information on boat availability.
- 2.2 Eligible teams must confirm entry not later Saturday, April 12th, 2025, by registering for the event online by confirming to kusailing@gmail.com

3 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, April 26th

9:00 a.m. - Check-in and rigging

9:30 am - Competitor's meeting

10:00 a.m. - Warning signal for first race, no warning signal after 5:00pm

Sunday, April 27th

8:30 a.m. Competitor's meeting

9:00 a.m. Warning signal for first race, no warning signal after 12:00pm.

Results of the regatta will follow the conclusion of racing and de-rigging of boats.

4 FORMAT

There will be one start for each division (A and B). Each division of each school shall sail the same boat for two races in a row and then rotate as directed. Racing will continue based on the Regatta Chairman's judgment within the published schedule of events.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 9:00am on Saturday, April 19th.

6 VENUE

The venue will be Perry Yacht Club. Races will be run on the waters in front of the club unless the race committee directs otherwise.

Races will be visible from the shore. Competitors will have access to the club facilities between Saturday April 26th and Sunday April 27th.

7 COACHING, TEAM MEMBERS AND SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and extra sailors are welcome however limited equipment or support boats. Spectators and coaches may view the races from the club or from spectator boats (as available).

8 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

Each team shall bring enough clothing and equipment to be properly attired for the conditions for sailing at one time, including US Coast Guard approved (Type 3 or 5) Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs). The PFDs must be available for inspection at registration. Teams shall also have consistent identification (pinnies or jerseys) that go over life jackets for easy identification of teams. (Football, basketball, and custom jerseys are acceptable as long as they match).
