- 3. Schedule of Events:



- 4. Boats & Format: 10 FJs, A/B Division. Sailing Instructions will be provided on site and to all registered teams.
- 5. Rotations: Depending on conditions, there will be on-the-water rotations or rotation from shore/boat. Further details will be provided at the Skippers Meeting.
- 6. Rules: This regatta shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS), the ICSA Procedural Rules (PR) for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition, and SAISA Rules and Regulations, except as any of these are modified by these Sailing Instructions
- 7. Registration: All competitors must be registered with the ICSA individual directory. Contact NC State coach Dana Magliola with any issues (dana@sailpack.org or 919.946.5445). Do your RP forms in advance of the event as MRP penalties will be issued upon finalization of the event Sunday, Feb. 23.
- 8. Uniforms: Pinnies must be worn by all competitors. Do not forget to bring your pinnies!
- 9. Food & Water: Bagels and fixins will be provided for all sailors on Saturday morning courtesy of NC State Sailing and the Greater Raleigh Sports Alliance.
