NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ICSA Procedural Rules, the PCCSC Standing Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Notices To Competitors:

3. Entry & Eligibility:

- 3.1. There is no limit placed on number of entries
- 3.2. There is a \$50 Entry fee per boat to help cover the cost of the event. Please pay by using our website.

- 3.3. All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail.
- 3.4. Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

4. Boats:

- 4.1. Teams will race PCCSC-legal CFJs to be provided by each team. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal CFJ sails.
- 4.2. Limited charter boats may be available, Please contact asusailingclub@gmail.com for information. If you are chartering you must bring your own race sails, **rudders, and tillers.** (Our tillers have a tendency to break so please bring your own. If this is an issue please let us know.)
- 4.3. If there is a shortage of charters, schools traveling the largest distances will be given priority. If you are able to bring an extra boat or rudders and tillers to the event, please let us know at asusailingclub@gmail.com, and we may be able to arrange someone to charter a boat from you.
- 4.4. Charters cost \$75 for the weekend and can be paid on our website.

9. **Courses:**

9.1. A Course Chart will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will describe the marks and courses.

10. **Scoring:**

10.1. The scoring system will follow the ICSA procedural rules.

11. **Protests:**

11.1. Protests shall be filed in accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules with the following change. "Race Committee" in PR 29(b) is changed to "Race Committee Finish Boat."

11.2. Written protests, including requests for redress and breakdowns, shall be filed with RC within 30 minutes of the last competitor's arrival ashore after racing has completed for the day.

11.3. Protest forms will be available at the main meeting location (see SI's)

11.4. Video, data and/or photographs taken from any source shall not be used as evidence at protest hearings. This changes RRS 63.6

12. **Housing:**

12.1. Teams are encouraged to camp with us at Spring Canyon next to Pleasant Harbor Marina. This year, camping is in a new central location, thanks to support from the Arizona Yacht Club.

- 12.2. IT GETS COLD AT NIGHT, Temperatures in the mid 40's are expected at night. Be sure to bring towels, toiletries, and other things needed.
- 12.3. Bathroom passes are available, make sure to stop by the Pleasant Harbor Office to pick them up. This will get you showers, plumbed sinks and toilets, and pool access. We recommend 1 pass for every 4 people. To avoid charge, return the cards at the end of the weekend.
- 12.4. There is a \$9 fee per car to enter the park each day.
- 12.5. Due to the remoteness of the venue, food will be provided in the form of
 - 12.5.1. Dinner on Friday and Saturday night
 - 12.5.2. Small lunch on Saturday and Sunday
 - 12.5.3. Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning
- 12.6. Teams should bring their own food for any major dietary restrictive needs, bigger lunches, snacks, and any additional meals they need. Please let us know and we will be planning to accommodate vegetarian and some gluten free meals.
- 12.7. Limited water will be available, teams should also bring their own water supply.
- 12.8. Teams are expected to respect all of the properties rules and policies. Please make note of:
 - 12.8.1. Quiet hours of 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM, Glass Containers Prohibited.
