



**Husky Women's Fleet Race 1 & 2**  
**February 7th and 8th, 2026**  
**Husky Sailing**  
**Sail Sand Point**



1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ICSA procedural rules, this Notice of Race, and Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

This regatta is open to schools which are registered and in good standing with PCCSC and ICSA. A school may bring unlimited women's teams. Each team shall consist of four or more currently eligible sailors from the same college/university.

3. REGISTRATION & FEES

Teams shall RSVP to the regatta by 8:00 pm Friday, January 30th, 2026. Teams shall RSVP using the online [PCCSC Live Schedule](#). An entry fee of \$30 per team will be collected at registration on Saturday morning. Teams may venmo @husky-sailing or make out a check to the "Husky Sailing Team".

4. BOATS & FORMAT

This regatta will consist of two one-day events. Saturday and Sunday will be scored separately, as Husky Women's 1 and Husky Women's 2, respectively.

This will be a combined-division (A & B Fleet) regatta sailed in FJs. **There will be no rotations - A and B fleet will sail the same course at the same time.** This is by majority a boat and sails provided event, but we are looking for a local team to volunteer to bring a couple of boats, contingent on the final number of signups. Boats and sails will be from UW's FJ fleet. Boat assignments will be posted by the main office and available on TechScore. 5. VENUE

Racing will take place in front of Sail Sand Point (7861 62nd Ave NE, Seattle, WA 98115). The competitors meeting and check-in will both take place in front of the main office. Parking for cars and trailers (including overnight) is available on site free of charge.

6. LAUNCHING & BOAT STORAGE

Teams are encouraged to launch their boats prior to the competitors' meeting. Trailers and dollies may be stored adjacent to the launch ramp during racing. Some boats may be kept on the dock overnight. Those not stored on docks will need to be stored on dollies and parked in a designated area overnight.
