 Silver Fleet Champs Regatta

RULES: This regatta shall be governed by rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the PCCSC Standing Rules.

Organizing Authority: The Organizing Authority (OA) is the UCSC Sailing Team in conjunction with the UC Santa Cruz Community Boating Center

FORMAT: Silver Fleet champs will be a two-boat rotational event with rotations occurring off of AA Dock.

ENTRY: There is an entry fee of \$30 per boat that will be due at registration. Teams must pay the entry fee for the event prior to the start of the event to be scored. Eligible teams will indicate how many boats they will be sailing via the PCCSC Live Schedule.

BOATS/SAILS: Teams will race PCCSC-legal FJs to be provided by each team. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal FJ sails. Limited charter boats from UCSC may be available. Please contact us at ucscsail@gmail.com for more information. Charter price is \$70 per FJ for the weekend. If you are chartering, you must bring your own race sails and blades. If there is a shortage of charters, schools traveling the largest distances will be given the charters. The final decision on who gets charters is up to the discretion of UCSC Sailing.

VENUE: The sailing venue will be the waters of Monterey Bay near the Santa Cruz Anchorage.

DOCUMENTATION: None needed

SAFETY: A U.S. Coast Guard-approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water. There will be 2 safety boats on the water at all times.
